What to Expect

Audio

- Loud music and noise
- Sudden changes in music
- Gunshot sound effects
- Bass vibrations
- Screaming
- Strong language and swearing

Visual

- Strobe and flashing lights
- Moving lights
- Moments of darkness and low light
- Physical contact between performers, fast movements, depictions of violence and suffering

Other

- Haze effects
- Clapping and cheering
