

# MINI THEATRE

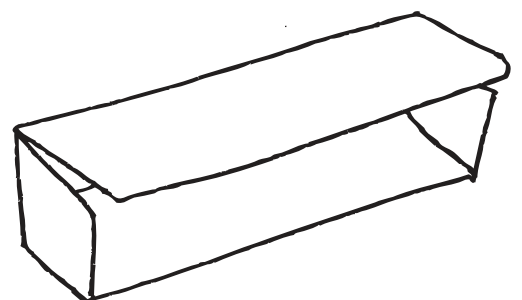


## You'll need the following (if possible!):

Scissors (an adult should use these unless you have child safety scissors)  
Glue Stick  
Shoebbox or similar  
Selection of coloured paper (or paper that you have painted or coloured in)  
Pens/crayons/pencil crayons  
Sellotape  
Extra cardboard

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the lid from your shoe box and cut down where the short end meets the long end on both ends of one side like this.



2. Cover the inside of your box with coloured or patterned paper, fix it in place with glue or sellotape. Decide which part will be the back of your theatre and draw a scene as a back drop.

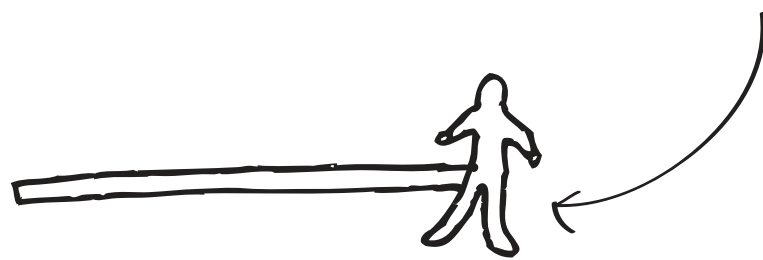
Backgrounds could be:

Back drop / background scene



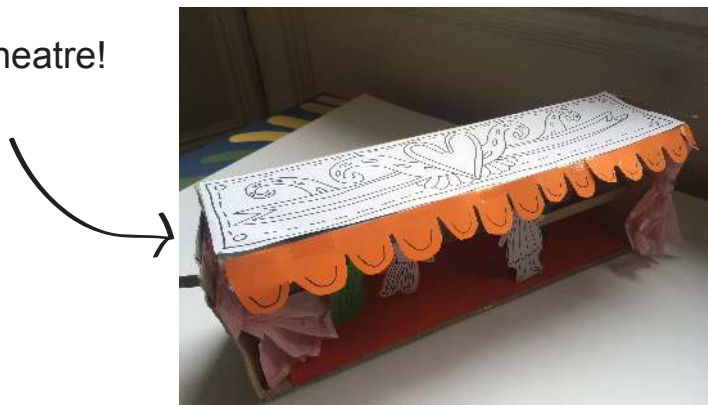
3. Create characters for your theatre. Draw the characters on paper, cut them out and stick them on card and then stick them to a strip of cardboard.



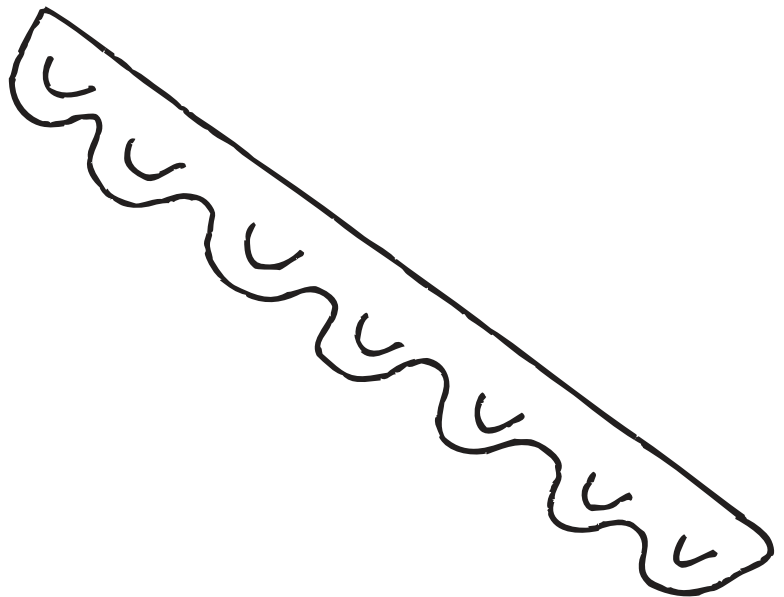
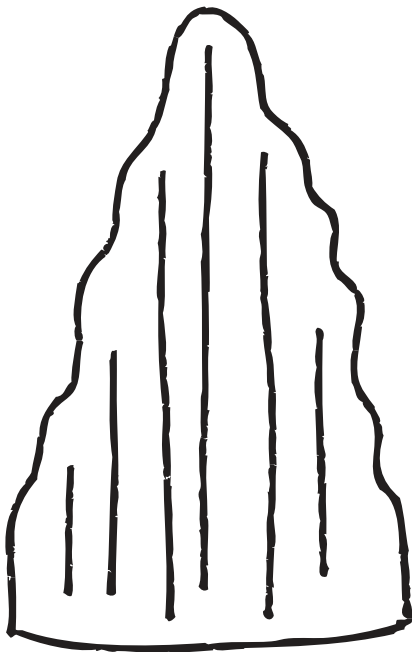
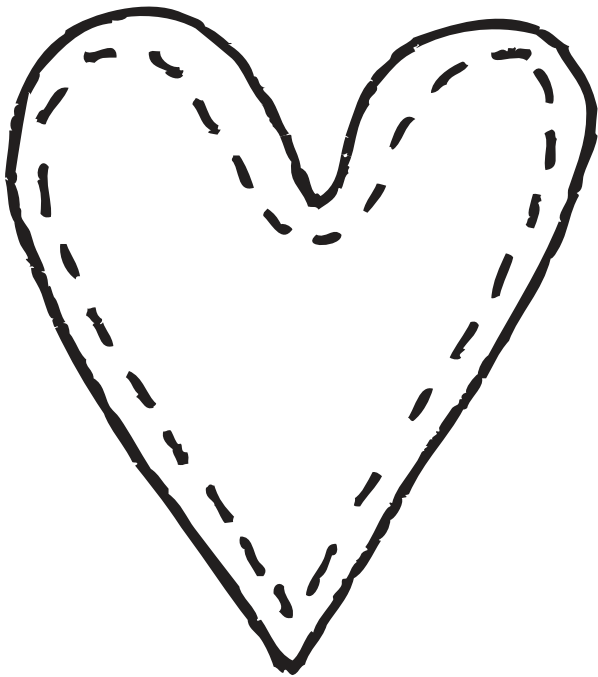
4. Cut slits / holes in the sides of your theatre so that your cardboard strips can fit through and you can move your characters about inside the theatre.



5. Decorate the outside of your theatre!
