



SATURDAY ART CLUB AT HOME

Welcome back to Saturday Art Club!

This week we are making Valentine's Day cards!

You'll just need 3 pieces of A4 card folded to make A5 cards and then just colour paper, glue, pens and scissors. Here are 3 ideas you could try... ..



SECRET LETTER

Cut out a paper heart and fold it lengthways. Then cut a piece of paper or card into a small rectangle and fold it in to 3 parts. Next, cut a small piece of card so that it's slightly smaller than one of the parts of the rectangle. Attach the rectangle to the front of one of your pre-prepared cards so that the centre panel is glued to your card and the two other sections fold on top of each other to create an 'envelope'. Write a message on the little piece of cardboard and put it inside the envelope. Seal the envelope with a sticker or a bit of

tape/glue. Paste your folded heart into the inside centre of your pre-prepared card, just along the fold. Add lots of hearts and decoration to the inside of the card



HUGGING HANDS

Cut out two hearts and two hands (you could draw around your own hands to make this on a bigger scale). Paste them onto the front of your next pre-prepared card so that one hand is at the top of your card holding a heart, and one hand is at the bottom of your card holding a heart.



FLORAL BOUQUET

Make a little cone out of your colour paper so that it looks like the paper around a bouquet of flowers. Stick it on to the front of your last card and add flowers coming out of the top of it. You could add a little personalised card or tag to the bouquet.
