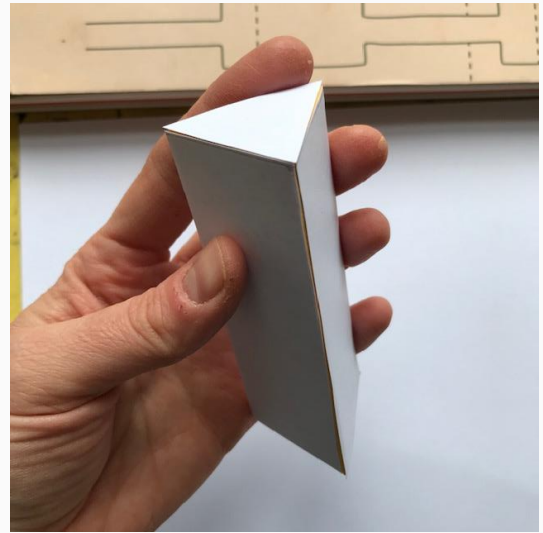
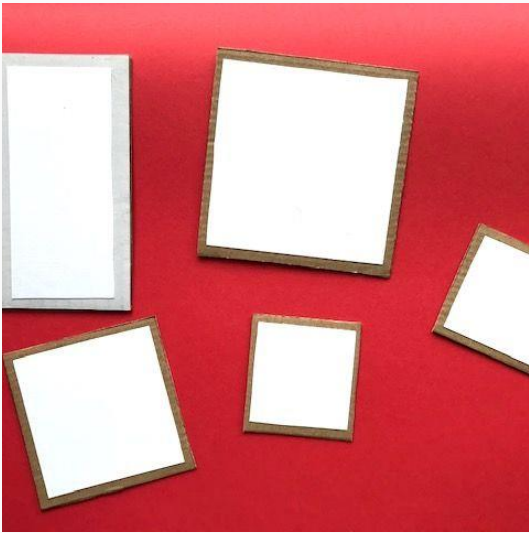
Creating a miniature or model gallery is a fun way to exhibit at home, but also to imagine and play with a real space that we might have visited, or would like to visit.

- experiment and have fun!
