

SPRING IN A BOX




You'll need the following (if possible!):

Scissors (an adult should use these unless you have child safety scissors)
Glue Stick
Shoebbox or similar e.g empty cereal box
Selection of coloured paper (or paper that you have painted or coloured in)
You could also use tin foil if you have some
Sellotape


INSTRUCTIONS

1. Remove the lid and one of the short sides off your shoebox. Cut down the sides as per diagram. Fold the two longer sides outwards. Your box should stand up.




2. Cover the inside of your box with coloured or patterned paper, fix it in place with glue or sellotape. You could also use paint or tin foil here!

3. Decorate the outer parts of your box with coloured paper cut in to strips, to create a 'fringe' effect.




Cut strips of paper to create a fringed effect




4. Decorate the inside of your box as you wish! You are aiming to create a 'Spring' scene. Think of Spring things that you could include such as: flowers, lambs, bunnies, sunshine....

To make the flowers I rolled up paper to make a tube and fixed it in place with sellotape. I then cut the bottom of the tube so that it was fringed all around and that I could stand it up and stick it down with tape. I made the petals by drawing heart shapes, cutting them out, folding them in half and taping them to the top of the flower.






Paper rolls for the flower stems
