EGG BOX OF DELIGHTS



You'll need the following (if possible!):

Scissors (an adult should use these unless you have child safety scissors)
Glue Stick

Selection of coloured paper (tissue and/or crepe paper is also good for this activity) Sellotape

An empty egg box

Coloured or painted card

Anything you could stick on the outside of the box such as sequins/glitter/etc

INSTRUCTIONS


1. Decorate the outside of your egg box to make it look as exciting as you can! I have chosen to make mine look as though it is a present tied up with a ribbon. Use lots of different colours and as much decoration as you can. Remember that you still need to open your box after you have decorated it! I made the ribbon effect by cutting 4 strips of coloured card. I then stuck 2 of the strips down to make the ribbon and created 2 loops with th other strips to look like a bow. I fixed the bow in place with sellotape.

- 2. Make some little 'treasures' out of cardboard to put inside the box. I have included the drawings I used to make mine at the end of this worksheet.
- 3. Fill your box with your treasures! I put shredded paper inside my box as well as my treasures and also put a drawing on the inside of the lid. Think about what you could use to make the inside of the box surprising and special.
