

PICTURE BLOCKS

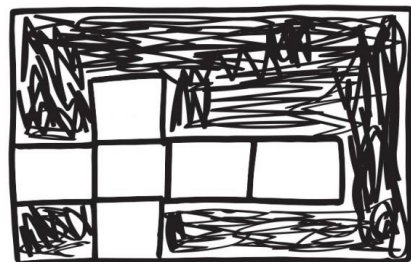


You'll need the following (if possible!):

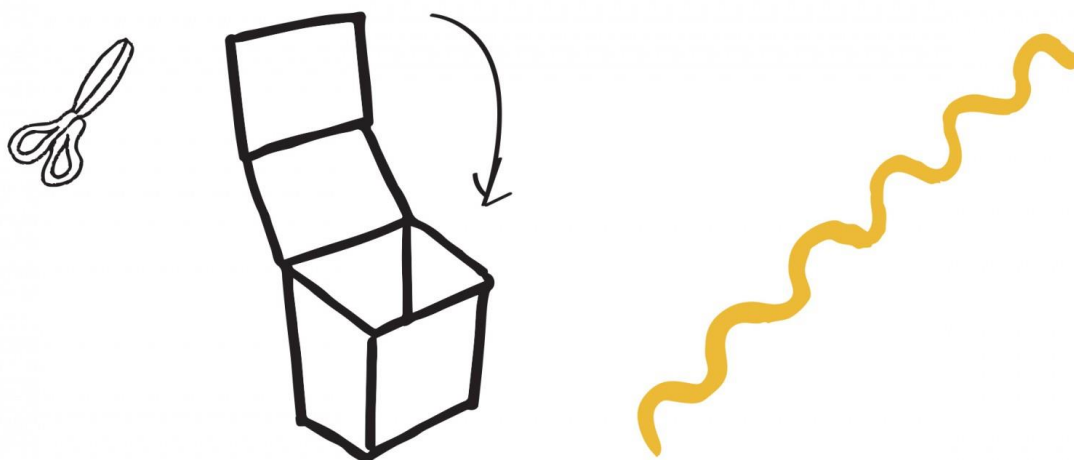
Scissors (an adult should use these unless you have child safety scissors)
Glue Stick
Cardboard
Paper
Pens
Sellotape

INSTRUCTIONS

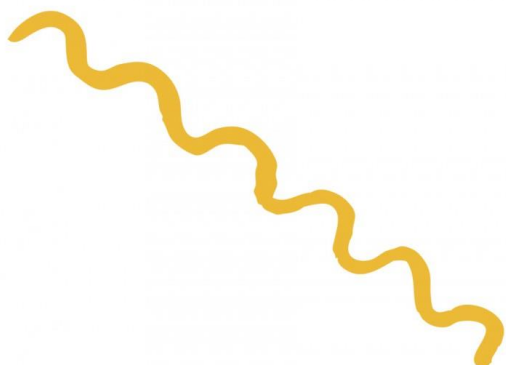
1. Start by making your blocks. To make 1 block use an A4 piece of card and draw a cross shape like this, made up of 6cm x 6cm squares



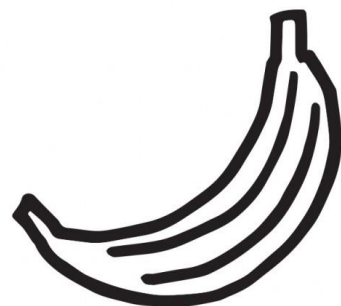
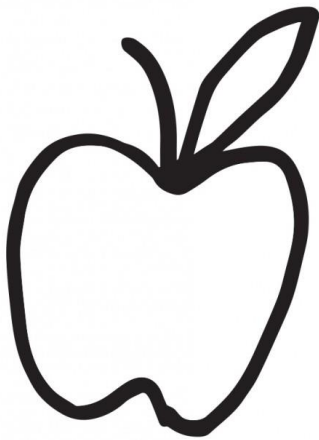
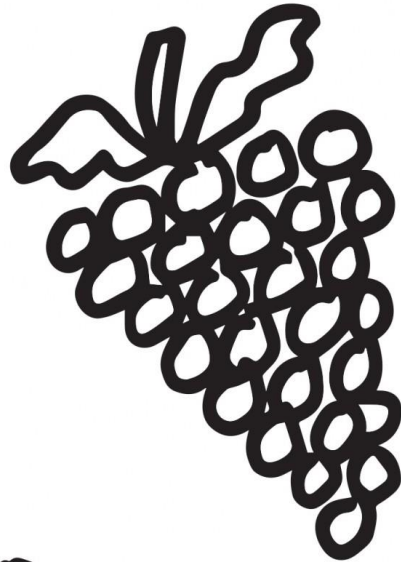
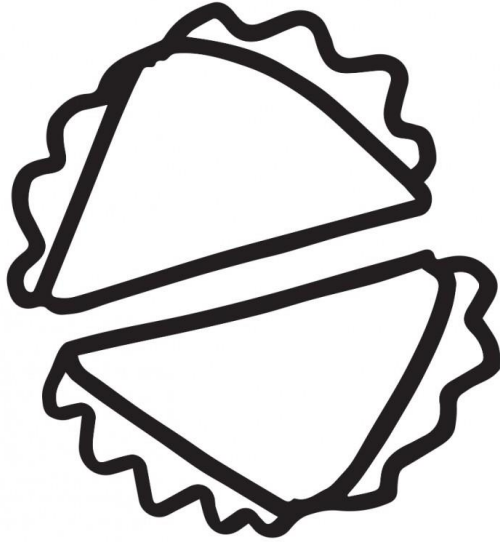
2. Cut out your cross shape and assemble the block by sticking the sides together with sellotape.



3. Assemble as many blocks as you like and then decide how you would like to use them. I decided to use my blocks to tell simple stories but you could make a game with your blocks, or just decorate each side differently. I drew my story pictures on white A4 paper with a felt tip before cutting them out and sticking them on the sides of the blocks with glue.
