

PRINTING WITH CARD



You'll need the following (if possible!):

Scissors (an adult should use these unless you have child safety scissors)
Paint
Paint Brush
Card (this should ideally be thick card)
Paper
A ruler or objects to draw around

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Start by cutting out your card board shapes. You may need an adult to do this as it can be quite hard to cut thick card. I used a ruler to make my squares and rectangles and then I drew around circular objects (like a roll of tape) to make my circles and semi-circles.

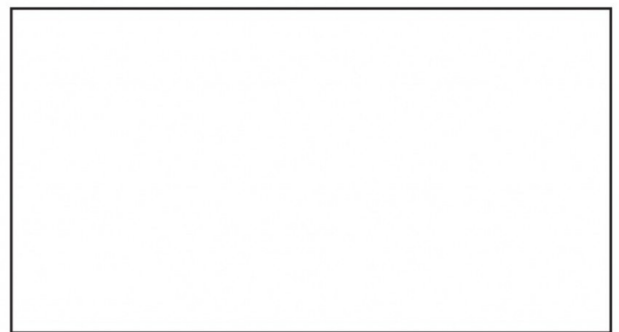
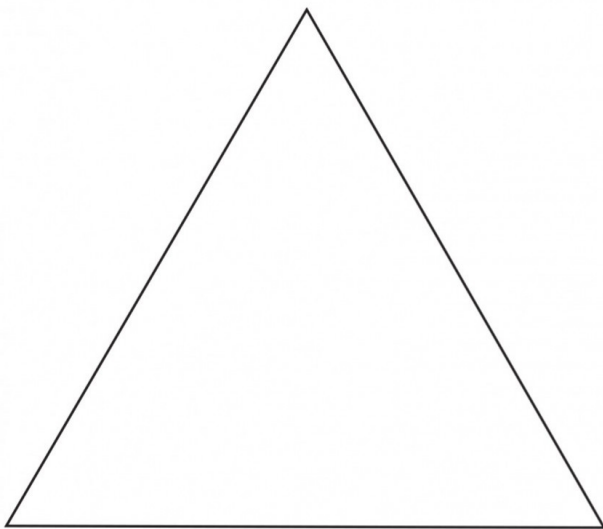
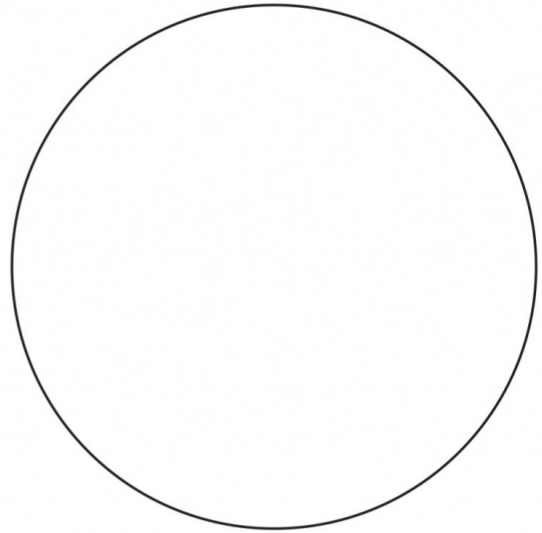
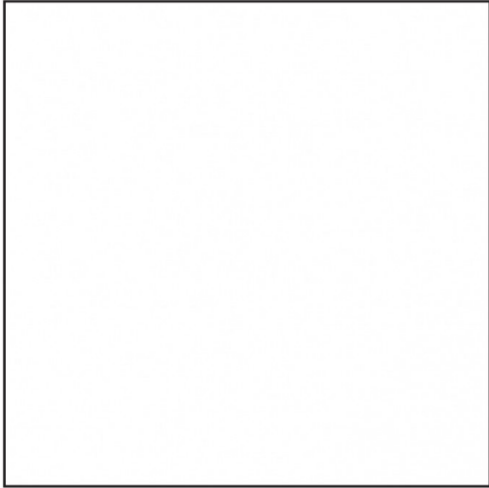
2. Use your paint brush to paint on to one side of the shape that you'd like to start printing with. Once you have painted one side, press the shape onto your paper to make the print. If you like, you can use the same shape several times before you add more paint as then some of your prints will appear more solid than others and this creates a nice effect. Repeat this step with all your shapes until you are happy with your picture!



NOTE

It might be a good idea to use a limited number of colours. Try just using 3 different colours and see what you think!
