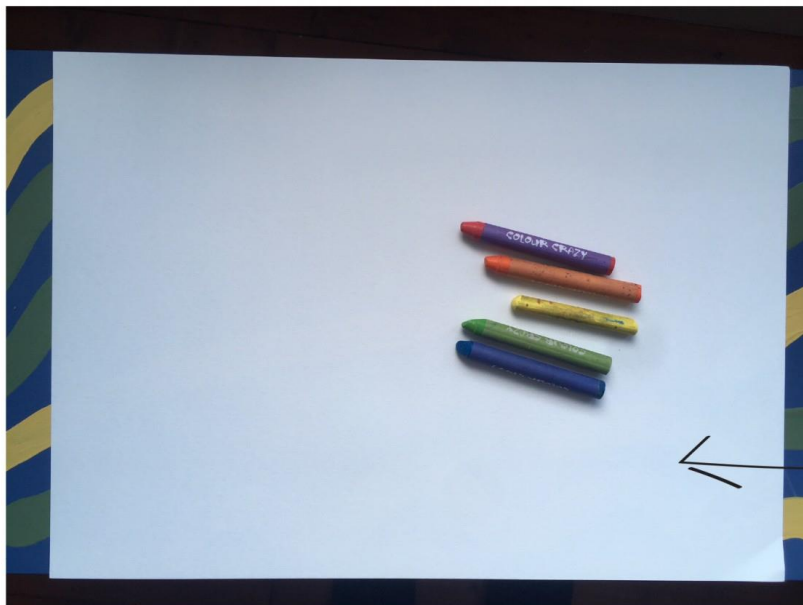


WAX AND WATERCOLOUR

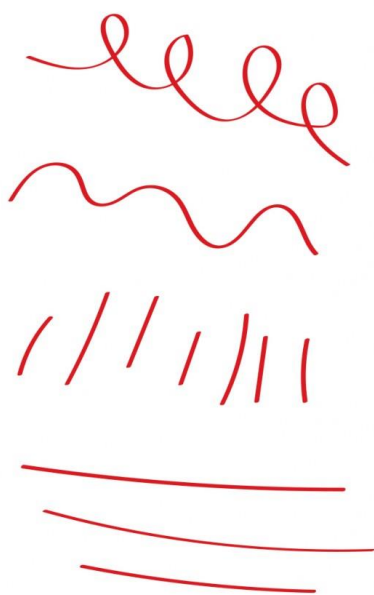
You'll need the following:

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Use your crayons to draw on your piece of paper- try and cover the whole piece of paper and use a variety of different shapes and lines.





2. Use your watercolours to paint over the top of the crayon drawings. Use a variety of colours and let your watercolours blend into each other.
